

BOWDISH, CRAIG C.

August 18, 1894-August 2, 1975

Craig Bowdish, 80, succumbed to a long illness Saturday, August 2, 1975, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. Funeral services will be Wednesday, August 6, 1975, at the Nazarene Church. Rev. Edward Haldy will conduct the services. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.
