

BOWEN, SJOENELLE ELAINE WINBURN

October 29, 1940-February 3, 2010

A memorial service for Sjoenelle Elaine Bowen, 69, was conducted at 11:00 A.M., Monday, February 8m 2010, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, Wyoming with Father Sione Lemeki as the Celebrant. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died February 3, 2010, at Cheyenne Regional Medical Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Sjoenelle was born October 29, 1940 in Denver, Colorado, the daughter of Byron S. and Charlotte Luella (Bowen) Winburn. Her childhood years were spent in La Junta, Colorado. The family moved to Denver when she was in the tenth grade; and, she graduated from West High School of Denver. After graduation, she attended Parks Business School, also in Denver. For a few years, she worked as a keypunch operator for a business in Denver. Sjoenella then married and became a housewife and mother. She was very artistic in her quilting, wearable art painting on fabrics, and crocheting. She made numerous baby items for family and friends.

Survivors include her son, Glenn Trinklein of St. Louis, Missouri; three brothers, Gene Winburn of Denver, Clifford Winburn of Show Low, Arizona and Larry Winburn of Wichita Falls, Texas; and numerous cousins.

She is preceded in death by her parents and an infant son.
