

BOWIE, ALEXANDER
1848-March 1916

Largely attended by old friends from near and far, the funeral of Alex Bowie took place Sunday afternoon from the Congregational church of this city. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Rev. W.B.D. Gray of Cheyenne, a long time friend of the deceased, had charge of the services and delivered a most feeling tribute to the dead. Masonic honors were bestowed both at the church and grave, and floral tributes were profuse and beautiful.

Among the many from a distance arrived to pay loving tribute to Alex Bowie were John Clay of Chicago, E.M. Banks of Alliance, Nebr.; Fred Haight of Denver, Frank Roach and George Abbott of Cheyenne, William Booker of Glenrock, E.T. David of Douglas. In addition to those mentioned, there were scores of old time friends and associates from surrounding points.
