

Funeral services for Betty Jane Bowman, 69, will be held Saturday, 10 a.m. at the Wheatland United Methodist Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Linda Barnes officiating.

Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Bowman died Wednesday, July 14, 1993 at the United Medical Center – West in Cheyenne.

She was born June 3, 1924, in Parker, S.D. to David and Dorothy Warren. She had lived in Wheatland for over 40 years with prior residence in Nebraska.

She attended the Saint Elizabeth Nursing School in Lincoln, Neb. She worked for 40 years in Wheatland as a nurse; first for Dr. Rosine as an office nurse; then for Dr. Allison; and then at the Platte County Memorial Hospital retiring in 1985.

She married George A Bowman in Wheatland on Nov. 23, 1948.

Bowman was named Pioneer Ranch woman of the Year in 1987. She was a member of the Wheatland United Methodist Church and the Dwyer Sewing Club.

Survivors include her husband, George of Wheatland; two children, Joe Bowman of Wheatland, Annabelle Echtenkamp of West Point, Neb; four grandchildren, Chad and Josh Bowman of Wheatland and Tom and Elizabeth Brophy of Modesto, Calif as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents and four infant children.
