

BOYD, NORA E.

Nora E. Boyd, 12-year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Adam Boyd of the Bluegrass country, died last Friday morning after an illness of 4 months duration. She is survived by her parents, two brothers, William and Francis of Wheatland, and by a grandmother and grandfather living in Ireland. She was a niece of William Irvine and James Irvine of Wheatland.

Nora was a member of the eighth grade graduating class this year and received her diploma at the commencement exercises at the Methodist Episcopal church in May. Altho she was ill at the time, she was taken to the church and was present on the platform with her classmates during part of the exercises.

The funeral was held at 2:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Methodist church, the Rev. H.E. Shepherd officiating. The pallbearers, all classmates of Nora, were Erma Hopper, Madeline Guilford, Julia Guilford, Dorothy Dillon, Hazel McCann, and Elizabeth Milne. Burial took place at the Wheatland cemetery. The Watson Mortuary was in charge.
