

BRANDLE, FERDINAND

December 10, 1860-February 21, 1945

Funeral services were held in the Methodist church Monday at 2 p.m. for Ferninand Brandle who died last Wednesday, February 21, in the Canon convalescent home in Douglas at the age of 87. The Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiated at the service and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Brandle was born of Austrian parents in Jersey City, N.J. on December 10, 1860. He left home at the age of 13, and was in business in New York City for several years before coming to Wyoming in 1908 and purchasing a ranch west of Wheatland. About 20 years ago, he and his wife moved to Wheatland where they made their home until her death in 1933. Mr. Brandle was affiliated with the Methodist church.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Emma Mannix of Omaha, Neb., and Mrs. Madge King of Cheyenne; three sons, W.H. Brandle of Hammond, Ind., Ben Brandle of Wheatland, and George Brandle of Colorado; also several grandchildren and great grandchildren.
