

Beulah "Evelyn" Brant

October 17, 1930 – January 14, 2008

A funeral service for Beulah "Evelyn" Brant, 77, was conducted on Friday, January 18, 2008, at Gorman Funeral Homes – Platte Chapel in Wheatland, Wyoming. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Monday, January 14, 2008, at her home surrounded by her family.

Beulah was born October 17, 1930, in Luray, Kansas, an only child to Charles Edmond "Charlie" and Beulah Alvira (McCoy) Ball. When she was nine, her mother passed away and Evelyn lived with her Aunt Bernice and Uncle Irwin Siemers. She attended school and helped raise her cousin, Galen Siemers. When Evelyn was 14, she lost her father in World War II. On September 18, 1952, Evelyn was united in marriage to Joseph George Brant after his military duty in the Korean War. From this union four children were born. Evelyn and Joe made a living on their dairy farm near Lucas, Kansas. Evelyn enjoyed working on the farm, milking cows, and raising her children. In 1971 Evelyn and her family moved to Wyoming and a new beginning. She enjoyed backpacking, water skiing, snow skiing, and working in her vegetable garden. She also loved to cook and bake, and always had a fresh loaf of whole wheat bread ready to eat. Evelyn loved to travel and visited Europe several times. She
