November 20, 1896-October 6, 1967

Mrs. John J. (Clare Adele) Brecht succumbed to a brief illness on Friday, Oct. 6, at the DePaul Hospital in Cheyenne. Mrs. Brecht, who had been a resident of this vicinity since 1952, was born in Washington, D.C. November 20, 1896.
