

Mrs. Dave Brice, Wheatland Resident For Many Years, Dies In California

Mrs. David W. Brice passed away Sunday, May 10, 1970, in Los Angeles, Calif., at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Paul Toy, after a lengthy illness.

Mrs. Brice was a former president of State Bank of Wheatland, now First National Bank in Wheatland, and a director of the bank at the time of her death. Her husband was a founder and long time officer of the bank.

Mrs. Brice was a charter member of the WTK Woman's Club and one of the organizers of the Wyoming Federation of Women's Clubs. She was also a member of the National Assoc.

of Bank Women, the Wyoming Historical Society, and one of the founders of All Saints Episcopal church in Wheatland.

Mrs. Brice was born in 1880 and in 1897 married David Watkins Brice. She is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Toy, a grandson David Brice Toy, and four great-grandchildren.

An Episcopal funeral was held in Los Angeles, Wednesday, and graveside services were in Wheatland, Thursday morning at 11 a.m.
