March 29, 1914-March 24, 1976

Roy M. Brickman succumbed Wednesday, March 24, 1976 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at the age of 61. Services were conducted by Mr. Daniel Barcus at the First Christian Church Friday, March 26, 1976 with interment at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Brickman was born in Laurel, Montana March 29, 1914. He married Elva W. Damrow October 31, 1939 in Harrisburg, Nebraska. Before his move to Wheatland in 1952, he had been a resident of Montana.

He had previously worked for the railroad in this area. Although retired at the time of his death, he had developed a very successful hog raising business.
