

Edith Hoffman Bridgmon

Funeral services for Edith Hoffmann Bridgmon, 95, of Laramie, and formerly of Wheatland, were held Wednesday, Dec. 29, 1993 at 11 a.m. at the Wheatland United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Linda Barnes officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Bridgmon died Saturday, Dec. 25, 1993 at Iverson Memorial Hospital. She was born Feb. 12, 1898 in Wheatland, the daughter of Augustus and Julia (Pfeiffer) Hoffman. She graduated from Wheatland High School and married Orvel L. Bridgmon on April 7, 1920 in Wheatland.

She spent her entire life in Wheatland until two years ago when she moved to Laramie.

She was a 50-year member of the Order of Eastern Star, a life member of the Wheatland United Methodist Church, the Wheatland Grange and Services for Seniors of Wheatland.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, two sisters, five brothers and one grandson.

She is survived by three daughters, Margaret Payne of Laramie, Marion Vogt of Wheatland, and Mildred Lawrence of Shawnee Mission, Kans., and one son, George Bridgmon of Laramie.

Also surviving are 11 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.
