

BRODERDORP, CARL AUGUST
1888-February 6, 1966

Carl August Broderdorp, 77, was born in Omaha, Nebr. He was married to Elva M. Vermilyea in Gering, Nebr. in 1915. Mr. Broderdorp moved to Guernsey in 1913 where he was employed as a railroad worker for CB & Q Railroad for thirty-three years before he retired. Death occurred on Feb. 6, 1966 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after a brief illness.

Relatives left to mourn are his sons, William C. of Fairbanks, Alaska and Joseph R. of Red Oak, Ia.; brothers, John and Edward and sister, Mrs. Clara Norgard, all of Omaha, Nebr. Seven grandchildren also survive. His wife, Elva, preceded him in death on Sept. 30, 1947.
