

**BROOKS, WILLIAM EDWIN**  
**August 13, 1885-August 28, 1959**

William Edwin Brooks was born August 13, 1885, in Illinois and passed away at Wheatland August 28, 1959, following an illness of one day. He was a retired city water supervisor at Wheatland and for the past nine months, had made his home in Chugwater. Before moving to Chugwater, he had lived in Wheatland for 35 years.
