

BROWN, BENJAMIN EMBRA

April 29, 1892-April 28, 1957

Funeral services were held Tuesday April 30 at 2 p.m. in the Schrader chapel for Benjamin Embra Brown 64, with Rev. J. B. Milstead officiating.

Mr. Brown, a retired farmer died at a local hospital following a short illness.

He was born April 29, 1892 to Annie Holmes and Thomas S. Brown near Kearney, Nebr. And had lived in various places in Colorado and Nebraska prior to his residence here since 1919. He was a World War I veteran and affiliated with the American Legion, VFW and Moose Lodge.

Survivors include his wife Ina M. Brown, Wheatland; one daughter, Mrs. Lavern Robinson, Wheatland; one brother, Russell A. Brown, Wheatland; one sister Mrs. Ira Johnson, Wheatland and three grandchildren.
