

# Mrs. Glen Brown passes away at hospital April 27

The community was deeply saddened last week end by the death of Helen Brown, wife of Glen E. Brown. Mrs. Brown passed away in Platte County Memorial Hospital April 27. Helen was loved by all who knew her for her cheerful personality, and her courage in her fight against cancer the past ten years.

She was born in Laramie July 5, 1908, the daughter of Peter and Ingeborg Olson Bothen. She received her education in the Laramie schools, also attending the University of Wyoming. On October 5, 1929 she married Glen E. Brown at Laramie, and had made her home here since 1942.

Mrs. Brown was a member of the Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, and was affiliated with the Indian Paint Brush Circle Kings Daughters organization. She was active in many clubs and organizations in Wheatland, and for many years had worked for the Platte County Welfare office.

Rev. Fred L. Stiegemeier conducted funeral services from the United Church of Christ, Wheatland, Monday at 2:00 p. m. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery, pallbearers being Don Willcuts, Andy Wilkie, Del Landen, George Grant, Harry Guenther and Russell Chasteen.

Besides her husband she is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Carl W. (Glenette) Johnson, Boulder, Colo.; a brother, Peter Bothen, Mesa, Ariz.; three sisters, Mrs. D. E. Hunton, Wheatland, Mrs. J. M. Mayhew, Laramie and Mrs. Alma Wymore, Casper; and two grandchildren. Her parents and two sisters preceded her in death.
