

BROWN, MARY E. METCALF
1852-December 18, 1912

Our citizens were grieved on Thursday morning to learn that Dr. Mary Metcalf Brown had passed away during the night, death occurring at 11:30 Wednesday night, December 18th.

The deceased had been seriously ill for some time and her death was not unexpected. Funeral services will be held today (Friday) at the M.E. church.

Mrs. Mary Metcalf Brown passed away at her home in Wheatland at 11:30 p.m. Wednesday, December 18th, after a lingering illness of almost a year. Death being caused by dropsy.

Mary E. Metcalf at Nilestown, Oneda county, New York sixty years ago. On May 2, 1911, she was united in marriage to Lyman Brown who was constantly with her during the last hours of her life. Deceased had lived in Wheatland about twelve years.

Besides the grief stricken husband, she leaves two sisters and a brother who reside in the east, Fred M. Ringrose, and a host of friends to mourn the loss of one whose every deed was an act of kindness.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. this afternoon at the M.E. Church, Rev. Hicks conducting the services. Interment will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
