

BROWN, RUSSELL AMZI
June 2, 1909-November 25, 1985

Services for Russell Amzi Brown, 76, who died in Wheatland, Nov. 25, were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home at 2:30 P.M. today with Chet Shaw, minister, and the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

Brown was born June 2, 1909 in Alliance, Nebr., the son of Thomas and Annie Holmes Brown. He spent his early childhood in Nebraska and at the age of 10 moved with his family to Wheatland where they homesteaded southwest of town on Slate Creek.

In 1933, he married Alice Combs in Wheatland. He ranched until the age of 62, at which time he retired, spending his retirement years in Wheatland.

Survivors include his wife Alice and a son, Darel Brown, both of Wheatland, a daughter, Barbara Noble of Belmont, Cal., a half-sister, Lois Cretchlow of Price, Utah, and four grandchildren.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by five sisters, one half-sister and one brother.
