

## Virginia Brown Dies Suddenly In Laramie

Mrs. Virginia Donna Brown, a former Wheatland resident, was found dead at her home at 1905 Rainbow, in Laramie, Monday by friends who were worried when she didn't report for work. Her body was discovered in bed at her home, where she lived alone, at 9:35 a.m. Albany County Coroner Joy Smith said Mrs. Brown apparently died of natural causes and that she probably had been dead since Sunday night.

Mrs. Brown was born in Ft. Madison, Iowa March 10, 1916 and lived in Wheatland many years before moving to Laramie.

She is survived by her husband Glen, of Laramie, a son, Larry L. Adams, of Jackson; a daughter, Mrs. Robert Martin, Casper; one step daughter, Mrs. Carl Johnson of Neenah, Wisc;

her mother, Mrs. Wanda Morrow, of San Pablo, Calif; two brothers, Ferris King, of Thermopolis and Roy King of Omaha, Nebr. and two half brothers, Jack and Babe Morrow, of La Somrante, Calif. She had eight grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held Friday, Sept. 18, at 2:00 p.m. at Schrader Chapel. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.
