

BROYLES, ARTHUR WILLIAM
July 25, 1894-August 25, 1926

Arthur William Broyles was born near Ottawa, Franklin County, Kans., July 25, 1894 and died Aug. 25, 1926. His parents lived in eastern Kansas for several years, then moved to Reno county, near Hutchinson, Kansas.

He lived near Bordeaux, Wyo., during the year 1914 with his brothers and sister, then returned to Kansas where he lived until three months ago, when he came to Wyoming.

He was converted and joined the Methodist Episcopal church at the age of 11 years.

He was in training at Camp Funston, Kans. during the World War. On Nov. 16, 1918, he was married to Miss Viola James. To this union were born four children, all of whom with his wife survive him. Ruth Viola, age 6, Grace Elizabeth, age 4, Edna May, age 2 years, and Arthur William, Jr., age 7 weeks, by two brothers and two sisters, Everett K. of Wheatland, Mrs. Cora Kinnamon of Bordeaux, Mrs. Grace Gudahl of Bordeaux, and Frank O. Broyles of Bordeaux.

Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery Friday, Aug. 27th.
