

BROYLES, EVERETT K.
December 1, 1883-July 9, 1935

Everett K. Broyles, 51, Wheatland citizen for the past 12 years, passed away Tuesday after an illness of long duration. Only his close friends knew of his sickness and his demise came as a shock to the community.

Funeral services are being held this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from the Methodist church with Rev. J.L. Williams in charge of the services. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Longwith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Broyles was born in Kansas December 1, 1883, and was 51 years, 7 months and 8 days of age at the time of his death. Together with his family he came to Wheatland and has lived here since. For a number of years he was employed by the Cooperating Marketing Association.

Besides his widow, he is survived by six children: Alice, Esther, Kelsey, Kenneth, Darrel and Clarence, all of Wheatland. He is also survived by two sisters, Mrs. J.S. Kinnamon and Mrs. O.B. Gudahl, both of Slater and a brother, Frank of Kansas. The latter person was here about three weeks ago for a short visit. He is also survived by nine nieces and nephews in Kansas and eight in Wyoming.
