Funeral services were held for Frances Elizabeth Bruegman Thursday, Aug. 16, 1979, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home with Rev. Delbert Dick officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Bruegman passed away Monday, Aug. 13, 1979, in Lakewood, Colo., after an extended illness.
