

5-14 JOHN G. BRUEGMAN 1985

Services for John G. Bruegman, 79, who died in Wheatland May 14, were held May 17 at 10:30 a.m. in the United Methodist Church with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

Born in Illinois on March 2, 1906, the son of John and Anna Bruegman, he came to Wyoming as a child, his family homesteading in the Hillsdale area. He was raised and educated in Hillsdale and was associated with his brother in ranching in the Burns area. Bruegman moved to Wheatland in the 1940's, bought his own ranch northwest of Wheatland, and operated the ranch until the time of his death.

He was a member of Wheatland Odd Fellows Lodge No. 29.

Survivors include his daughter, Jackie Hixson of Phoenix; two step-daughters, Donna Kukuchka of Denver and Wanda Drusch of Manhattan, Mont; one brother, George Bruegman of Cheyenne; eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Frances and a sister, Marie.

A Memorial in his name has been established to the Platte Co. Senior Citizen's Center.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
