

BURKE, MARVIN KENNETH
August 31, 1921-October 25, 1940

Marvin Kenneth Burke died Friday at the age of 19 years. He had been in poor health since he was six years old.

He is the son of Olive and John Burke, and was born in Beemer, Nebr. on August 31, 1921. He moved with his parents to Stanton, Nebr. where they resided several years. In 1928 the family moved to Wyoming and lived south of Wheatland until within the last year they moved to Glendo.
