Dora Burnett, 95, an Albany County resident until the past few years, died Sept. 18 at the Plaza County Memorial Hospital.

She had lived the past 13 years with her son, Arthur (Buster) Burnett and his wife Ellen, of Wheatland.

She was born Feb. 21, 1883, in Albany County and was raised near Garrett Community, attending schools in Rock Creek and Salt Lake City, Utah, where she received a teaching certificate. She taught school at Garrett before marrying Matthew Burnett.
