

Services for James Anderson Burney, 79, who died July 22, will be held today at 2:30 p.m. in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Delbert Dick officiating.

Burney was born April 19, 1906 in Tekamah, Nebr., the son of George and Grace Burney. At an early age he moved with his family to Scottsbluff, Nebr., and at age 13, to New Raymer, Colo., where he received his education.
