

BUSH, GEORGE ELMER
August 18, 1892-November 6, 1918

George Elmer Bush died on Wednesday night, Nov. 6, after several days illness following an attack of influenza.

He was born at Freeman, Cass county, Missouri on Aug. 18, 1892. In 1902 he moved to Wheatland where he resided until his death. In March, 1915, he was united in marriage to Miss Rosetta Petty, who, with their one child, Marvin, aged two and one half years, survive him. His aged mother is still living, also three brothers and six sisters, all of whom are residents of Wheatland, except one brother, Thomas, who is with the American army in France. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. R.F. Paxton Friday afternoon from the Pepper mortuary and the body was laid at rest in the Wheatland cemetery. He made many warm friends who deeply regret his untimely departure from earthly toil.
