

BUSSARD, VIOLA FRANCES GRAY
August 16, 1910-January 25, 1979

Funeral services for Viola Frances Bussard were held Monday, January 29th 1979, at the First Christian Church with Daniel Barcus officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mrs. Bussard died Thursday at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.
