

BUTRICK, ORAN WESLEY
April 21, 1894-July 18, 1966

Death claimed Oran Wesley (Jack) Butrick at his home in Wheatland on July 18, 1966 following an extended illness. He was born in Bigelow, Mo. on April 21, 1894 and served with the army in World War I. On Nov. 16, 1921, he married Marie L. Shepard in Fortescue.

The Butricks resided in Guernsey from 1943 until 1958 when they moved to Wheatland where Mr. Butrick was employed at Blow Oil Co. for seven years before his retirement. He was a member of the Southern Baptist church and AF & AM No. 49.

Surviving relatives include his wife Marie of Wheatland; son, Jack L. Butrick and daughter, Mrs. J.A. Moses, both of Cheyenne, and a brother, L.P. Butrick of Hyde Park, N.Y.

Rev. Forrest Upchurch conducted last rites at the Southern Baptist church on July 21, at 2:00 p.m. Masonic services were held at the graveside at the local cemetery.
