April 8, 1916-January 22, 1939

Young, lovely and beloved by all who knew her, a sudden brief illness took her from our midst. Vonita became ill last week and was taken to Cheyenne for treatment. She was operated on Saturday morning and died Sunday without regaining consciousness.

Vonita Margaret Campbell, oldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. C.W. Campbell of Slater, was born April 8, 1916, Hardtnee, Kansas, and departed life on January 22, at the age of 22 years, 9 months and 13 days.

Vonita came with her parents to the Slater community in 1924.

Surviving are her parents and three sisters, Leona, Irene and Jennalee. A brother passed on in infancy.

Funeral services were held Wednesday in the Congregational church with Rev. Flenner in charge. Mrs. George Williams sang two songs with Mrs. Peters as accompanist.

Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
