

CARBERRY, RONALD LANE
September 29, 1949-June 21, 1973

Funeral services were held Monday, June 25, 1973 at 10:30 a.m. for Ronald Lane Carberry, 23, at the United Church of Christ with Rev. Ronald F. Simms officiating.

Mr. Carberry was seriously injured Thursday, June 21, 1973 at 1:15 a.m. in a one car accident south of Douglas. He was en route to Casper when he apparently fell asleep and left the roadway. He died later at the Converse County Hospital.

Ron was born in Wheatland September 29, 1949. He was a lifetime resident of Wheatland. He married Raeanne Pfaff on Sept. 17, 1972 in Wheatland. He was employed at the time of death as a lineman-apprentice at the REA and had been employed there 9 months. He served in the U.S. Army in Viet Nam and was awarded the Bronze Star. Ron was affiliated with the Episcopal Church and was a member of DeMolay.

Ron is survived by his wife, Raeanne & daughter, Barbara Jo, at home. Also surviving is his mother, Mrs. Bernetta Carberry; two brothers, Don Carberry, Wheatland and Robert Carberry of Riverton; four sisters, Leola Carberry, Wheatland, Mrs. Carolyn Montoya, Lakewood, Colorado, Mrs. Jolene Fish, Rapid City, South Dakota, Mrs. Betty Hamilton, Central Point, Oregon.
