

# Harvey Edgar Carey

Funeral services for Harvey Edgar Carey, a resident of Wheatland, were held Saturday, March 19, 1988 at the First Christian Church, with Dan Barcus officiating.

Harvey Carey was born July 5, 1902, in Alva, Oklahoma, the son of Edward and Mary Elizabeth (Jonas) Carey. He was raised and educated in Oklahoma and at the age of 18 came to Slater, Wyoming. On September 25, 1927, he married Cora Carter in Wheatland. After their marriage they farmed in the Slater and Wheatland area. In 1955 they moved to town and Harvey became associated with the C&S Railroad where he worked until his retirement in 1964. He spent his retirement years in Wheatland.
