

**C. Oscar Carlson
Yoder, Dies in
Torrington, Sunday.**

Carl Oscar Carlson, 63, of Yoder, succumbed to an extended illness on Sunday, September 19, 1971 in the Goshen County Hospital in Torrington.

He was born April 27, 1908 in Rockford, Ill, the son of Charles Emil and Ida Larson Carlson. Following his education in schools in that vicinity, he first came to Wyoming in the late 1920's and married Leva Rutherford of Dwyer, in 1933. They resided in Illinois for a number of years then moved to the Yoder-Veteran area in 1946 where he was engaged in farming until his retirement in 1965, due to failing health. Mr. Carlson was affiliated with the Lutheran Church and was a member of the Farmer's Union.

Surviving him are his wife, Leva, four sons, Car O., Jr, Veteran; Charles, Long beach, Calif; George H, Granby, Colorado; Jack T., Walden CO; two daughters, Kathy, Yoder; Mrs. Ray (Illa) Valentine, Old Town, Fla.; one sister, Ms. Elsie Carlson, Rockford, Ill; one aunt, Mrs. Rozella Carlson, Galesberg, Ill.; sixteen grandchildren and a number of cousins.

Services were held Wednesday, September 22, 1971 at 1:30 p.m. at the Sutley Funeral Chapel in Torrington with Rev. Burton Kugler of the South Goshen Presbyterian Church officiating.
