

Oscar W. Carlson

January 20, 1906-April 26, 2000

Services for Oscar W. Carlson, 94, were held Tuesday, May 2, 2000, at 11 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Wheatland with Reverend Les Ludlam officiating. Inurnment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Oscar was born January 20, 1906, in Webster City, Iowa, the son of Fred and Julia (Bergman) Carlson. The family later moved to Wyoming where they homesteaded north of Uva. They eventually moved to Wheatland where Oscar, his two brothers, George and Elmer and sister, Mabel grew up.

Oscar married Irene Barnes on November 9, 1929, in Greeley, Colo. Oscar worked for the Burlington Railroad in Wyoming, Colorado and Texas; and upon retirement, returned to Wheatland. He was a member of the Masons, Knight's Templar and Eastern Star and was an avid golfer. Oscar was a role model for his family and will be deeply missed by his family.

Oscar is survived by two sons, Norman Carlson of Sherman, Texas and George Carlson of Westminster, Calif.; a sister, Mabel Artery of Wheatland; four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Irene on March 26, 1997; and two brothers, George and Elmer Carlson.
