

CARTER, CHARLES HENRY

May 8, 1887-October 1, 1937

Charles Henry Carter was born near Holbrook, Nebr., May 8, 1887 and passed away October 1, 1937 at the age of fifty years and a few months.

Mr. Carter was united in marriage to Mary Boehn of Holstead, Kans. on Nov. 28, 1906. Five children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Carter, all of whom are living, Carl William, Cora Alice, Lawrence Ellsworth, Vera Florence and Charlie Milton, all of Wheatland except Cora Alice, who resides in Kiowa, Kansas, having moved there two years ago.

Besides his wife and children, he is survived by his father, two brothers and one sister. His father, Milton Carter, and his older brother, James Edward and sister, Ella Adamson reside in Nebraska. His younger brother, Ezra Alfred Carter lives near Wheatland. His mother and one sister passed away when Mr. Carter was a small child. He is also survived by eleven grandchildren.

Mr. Carter came to Wyoming in May, 1918 and had made his home in Platte County on his homestead, until three years ago, when he moved near Wheatland.

Funeral services were held from the Watson & Dennis Funeral home at ten a.m. Monday with Rev. Ralph Underwood officiating. Interment being held in the Wheatland cemetery.
