Funeral services for Grace E. Carter, '88, were held Friday, Nov. 4, 1994 at 2 p.m. at the Memorial Baptist Church, 101 14th Street in Wheatland, with Pastor Lynn Nikkel officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Grace died Tuesday, Nov. 1, 1994 at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland where she had been a resident for the past 10 years.

She was born Oct. 11, 1906 in Nebraska City, Neb., the daughter of William and Lula May (Peterson) Mickle. The family moved to Rock Creek, Wyo., in 1910 where her father worked on a ranch. In the 1920s, her family moved to the Wheatland Flats.

She married Maurice Eshom in 1926, and to that marriage, three children were born, Bob, Vivian and George. After Mr. Eshom's death, she married Charles E. Carter in 1946. Grace loved small children, making quilts and flowers.

Grace is survived by two children, Bob Eshom of Guernsey, and Vivian Perdue of Wheatland. Also surviving are a brother, Ralph Mickle of Phoenix, Ariz., 12 grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Carter was preceded in death by her parents, her husbands, Maurice Eshom in 1946 and Charles E. Carter in 1984, a son, George Eshom in 1965, a sister and two brothers.
