Beatrice Dora Bennett Chambers

Memorial services for Beatrice Dora Bennett Chambers, 76, will be Thursday, July 30, at 11:00 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Mrs. Chambers died on Sunday July 26 after a lengthy battle with diabetes at the Memorial Hospital of Laramie County in Cheyenne.

She was born October 6, 1915 on the family homestead west of Jay Em, Wyoming, the daughter of Arthur and Emma (Weiser) Brown. She attended school through the eighth grade at Morris Springs School. In order to attend Ft. Laramie High School, she milked cows for families to pay her room and board. Bea played basketball while attending Ft. Laramie High School.

She married Claude Chambers on May 5, 1950 in Wheatland. She worked outside helping with the farming activities. Bea loved animals and raised and broke many horses as well as caring for any animal that was in need. She was an avid swimmer and participated in

many activities at the Black Mountain Recreation Center. Bea was active in VFW Post #3558 and Women of the Moose. She had earned the College of Regents Degree, the highest degree in the Wheatland Chapter.

Mrs. Chambers is survived by her husband, Claude, (from Wheatland), and a son, Lloyd Bennett of Lawton, Oklahoma. Also survivors include two brothers, Robert Brown of Cheyenne, and Russell Brown of Salt Lake City, Utah; two nieces, Shirley Lungaro of Baton Rouge, La., and Jeanette Adams of Fremont, Ne; two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, one brother, Richard Brown, and a daughter.
