1891-1997

Lowell Clark, 105, of Wheatland, died Tuesday at Platte County Nursing Home.

He was born Oct. 14, 1891, in Chiowa, Neb. He had lived in Lincoln, Neb., before moving to Wheatland in 1919.

Clark attended Lincoln Business College.

He had been a farmer and later worked at a Continental Oil Company bulk plant for 10 years, at a garage and as a janitor before being hired as deputy treasurer in Platte County. He served in that position for eight years. He was elected Platte County Treasurer, serving a four-year term. He retired in 1969. He served in the U.S. Army during World War I.

Clark married Dora Caroline Beerink on March 21, 1920, in Wheatland.

He was a member of the Wheatland United Methodist Church and Wheatland Masonic Lodge 16 A.F. & A.M. Blue Lodge.

Clark is survived by two daughters, Eileen R. Oliver of Wheatland and Lois Dorothy Middleswarth of Henry, Neb.; five grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Dora Clark in 1973; one daughter, Carol Vianna Clark in 1942; his parents, Daniel and Vianna Clark; seven brothers and sisters; and two grandchildren.

Visitation will be held from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. today and from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Thursday.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with the Rev. Linda Barnes-Patzke officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.
