

CLEMENT, HOMER RICHARD
December 26, 1900- June 13, 1978

Services for Homer Richard Clement were held Friday, June 16, 1978, at 2:00 p.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel. Dan Barcus officiated at the service. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Clement passed away Tuesday, June 13, 1978 at his home in Wheatland at the age of 77.

Homer was born to James and Emma Clement on December 26, 1900 at Hamburg, Iowa. He grew up and lived in the Hamburg area until 1925 when he came to the Wheatland area to farm with his uncle, C.C. Beck. He entered the Army during WWII and was a maintenance mechanic. He served part of his stint overseas during the war.

After Homer was discharged from the Army, he came back to Wheatland to farm. He farmed with his uncle up until the time his uncle died and then began working as a hired hand on various farms and ranches in the area.

He is survived by his son, James Clement of Wheatland; a daughter, Isabel Ruby of Lincoln, Nebraska; and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother and two sisters.

Serving as pallbearers were Leland Stevens, Don Throckmorton, Cleve Artery, Elmer Leth, George Weaver and Ken Hermann. A memorial has been established to the Senior Citizens. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements.
