

## 11-2-1987 Louis Edwin Colby

Graveside services for Louis Edwin Colby, 68, who died in Wheatland Nov. 2, 1987, were held in Wheatland Cemetery at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, Nov. 4, 1987 with Marlin Driscoll officiating.

Born in Wheatland, June 11, 1919, he was the son of Edward and May (Feltz) Colby. He was raised on the family farm west of Guernsey and attended the Guernsey schools. In 1936 he moved to Chicago where he worked as an appliance repairman.

He entered the U.S. Air Force and served during World War II in France, Germany and England. Upon being discharged he worked for Kodak for a short time, then became associated with IBM. He worked his way up to systems specialist, working in many different countries.

He retired 7 years ago and spent his retirement in North Ft. Myers, Fla., until ill health caused him to return to his home in this area.

He is survived by one brother, Raymond Colby of Hurricane, Utah.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by two brothers, Thomas and Harlon, and a sister, Edna.
