

COLEMAN, HARVEY C.  
November 19, 1897-May 21, 1970

Harvey C. Coleman passed away on Thursday, May 21, 1970, of an extended illness at the age of 72. Mr. Coleman had been a resident of Wheatland since 1938. He was retired from the Platte County Welfare of which he was director for many years.

He was born in Ulysses, Nebr., on Nov. 19, 1897. He married Aimee Alice Cumming and served in the U.S. Navy in World War I. He was a member of the AF & AM 16, Consistory Number 1, Koroin Shrine, IOOF, American Legion and Past Associate Guardian of Jobs' Daughters.

Mr. Coleman received a Bachelor's of Arts degree in education from Cotner College in Lincoln, Nebr. in 1920 and a Master's degree in school administration in 1938 from the University of Wyoming.

He taught in several Nebraska schools beginning in January, 1921 and later served the Veteran, Laramie and Wheatland school systems. Coleman was grade school principal in Wheatland from August, 1938 until his appointment as Platte County Welfare director in July, 1941.

His wife, Aimee Alice preceded him in death in 1961. He is survived by one son, Bruce Coleman of Casper, and one daughter, Mrs. Ida Lou Bramlet of Lusk and four grandchildren.

Funeral services were held on Saturday, May 23, at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Dean Addington officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery with Masonic graveside services.
