April 4, 1892-January 15, 1961

Funeral services for Mrs. Jennie Ruby Cook were held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with Mr. Olin Atwood officiating. Mrs. Cook passed away January 15 in Cheyenne, where she had lived the past five years.

Born in Nodaway County, Mo. On April 16, 1892, she and her late husband, John W. Cook, homesteaded in Wheatland in 1914. Later Mrs. Cook moved to Wheatland before going to Cheyenne to make her home.
