Pluma B. Copley, 89, died Saturday, June 21, at the Fremont Manor Nursing Home in Riverton.

She was born in Ogallala, Neb., February 20, 1891 and was married to Laurens Copley in 1913.

Shortly after they were married, the couple came to Slater, Wyo. where they lived for a short time then moved to Florida.

They returned to Wyoming and settled in Wheatland where they opened a furniture store and later a funeral home.

In 1941, her husband died and she operated the business for a short time before her firm was purchased by the Schrader Funeral Home.

She moved to Thermopolis six years ago and moved to Riverton in 1976 and has resided there until the time of her death.

She was a 50 year member of the Order of the Eastern Star and an active member of All Saints Episcopal Church in Wheatland.
