Funeral services for Robert R. Daly, long-time Wheatland resident, were Monday, July 12 at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home.

Interment services followed at the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Daly died Thursday, July 8.

He was born October 17, 1920, in Torrington to Jesse and Parmelia Daly where he lived until 1936 when he moved to Wheatland.

He was married on July 13, 1941, in Wheatland to Alice G. White. They resided in Steamboat Springs, Colo. for a year before he entered World War II.

He served in the 8th Air Force in England and the 15th Air Force in Italy. Following the war they returned to Wheatland.

Mr. Daly owned and operated a plumbing and heating business for over 30 years. He was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church for many years and served for over 25 years on the Board of Trustees of the Fletcher Park Baptist Youth Foundation. He belonged to the VFW and was an honorary member of the FFA.

Survivors include his wife Alice and two children, Mike C. Daly of Wheatland and Robin Daly Schuermann of Olympia, Wash; one grandson, Sam Daly; one sister, Dorothea Laux of Roswell, New Mexico; one brother, Lawrence Daly of Paradise, Calif., and many nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased in death by his parents, four brothers and three sisters.
