

WADE, ELSIE
February 2, 1882-August 21, 1965

Elsie Daniel Wade died suddenly at her home in Wheatland on August 21, 1965 at the age of 83. She was born in Rockport, Mo. on February 2, 1882 and married Charles W. Daniel there in Jan. 1904. They later moved to Hyannis, Nebr. and resided there before coming to Wyoming in 1914, in a covered wagon, to settle on a farm northwest of Wheatland. Mrs. Wade was a member of the Christian church and the Grandmothers' club.

Her first husband, Charles Daniel, preceded her in death in 1921. She later married Virgil Wade who also preceded her in death. Surviving relatives include her children, Ralph Daniel, Deeth, Nev., Mrs. Inez Wilson, Wheatland, Mrs. Marjorie Vonberg, Casper, Mrs. Dorothy Smith, Denver, and Mrs. Catherine Stugart of Denver; a sister, Mrs. Jessie Clifton, Rockport, Mo.; 11 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.
