

DAWSON, EVERETT JACKSON
March 11, 1889-January 11, 1967

Last rites for Everett Jackson Dawson, 77, will be held at the Schrader Chapel on January 13 at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Dawson, a retired farmer, was born in Warsaw, Mo. on March 11, 1889, and served in World War I. He came to Wheatland in 1910 and married Leota Kindt in Pueblo, Colo. on March 9, 1937. Death occurred in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on January 11, 1967 after an illness of three weeks.
