

DAY, ROY WILTON
June 26, 1907-April 14, 1967

Graveside services for Roy Wilton Day, 59, former Wheatland resident, were held at the local cemetery on April 19, with Rev. Ralph Martin officiating.

Mr. Day was born in Akley, Minn. on June 26, 1907 and resided in Wheatland from 1909 until 1941 when he moved to Denver. Death occurred in Denver on April 14, 1967 following a lengthy illness. He was a member of the Baptist church.
