

4-30-1985 CHARLOTTE DINGES

Services for Charlotte Dinges, 71, who died in Cheyenne April 30, were held Saturday, May 4, at 9:00 a.m. in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Pastor Jim Hicks officiating.

Dinges was born March 28, 1914, in Fon du Lac, Wisconsin, the daughter of Alex and Charlotte Fresorger. The family moved from Wisconsin to Colorado in 1920, then to Wyoming in 1931. She married David Dinges, January 1, 1933. The couple farmed in the Wheatland area until 1957. They owned and managed the D & C Cafe for several years until his death. Charlotte continued to work at various jobs until she became ill.

She is survived by two sons, Richard Dinges of Newcastle and David Dinges of Escondido, Cal., four brothers: Alec Fresorger of Wheatland, Paul Fresorger of Bayard, Neb., Chris Fresorger of Sheridan, Albert Fresorger of Sheridan, eleven grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Besides her husband she was preceded in death by her parents, two daughters, and three brothers.
