

DIXON, BENJAMIN LEWIS  
September 24, 1887-September 9, 1937

Benjamin Lewis Dixon, son of Mr. and Mrs. Wm. Dixon, who was born on Sept. 24, 1887 in Livingston, Kentucky, passed away in Wheatland last Thursday, Sept. 9, 1937. His death was caused by an arterial heart condition from which he had been suffering for some time.

Mr. Dixon came to this community some eighteen years ago, and for several years was connected with the Elkin Chevrolet Co. in Wheatland. At the time of his death, he was deputy state game warden.

He is survived by his wife Irma Dixon, whom he married a little more than a year ago. Had he lived a few weeks longer, Mr. Dixon would have reached the age of fifty years.

Funeral services were conducted Sunday afternoon from the Congregational church, with Rev. Flenner in charge, and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
