

DONALDSON, GEORGE P.
November 14, 1870-March 21, 1950

George P. Donaldson, 80, who had lived on a ranch 30 miles northwest of Wheatland for 46 years, died suddenly Tuesday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Thomas Gibb, in Wheatland.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 2:00 p.m. in the Methodist church with the Rev. Howard Rice in charge of arrangements.

Born near Davenport, Ia., November 14, 1870, Mr. Donaldson had lived at the ranch since 1904.

His survivors include his wife, Mrs. Eva Donaldson; four children, Mrs. Gibb, Mrs. Ethel Forbes of Cheyenne, Ross Donaldson of Dwyer, and C.E. Donaldson of Cheyenne; three half-brothers; three half-sisters; four grandchildren and five great grandchildren.
