

Goldine J. Driscoll

Graveside funeral services for Goldine J. (Cartwright) Driscoll, age 79, were held at the Wheatland Cemetery with the Rev. Karin E. Wade officiating. Mrs. Driscoll died Saturday, Oct. 27 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland following a long illness.

Goldine Jewell Driscoll was born March 18, 1911 at Creston, Iowa, the daughter of George and Eunice (Reed) Cartwright. At an early age, the family moved to North Platte, Neb., where she was reared and educated, graduating from North Platte High School.

She then attended Colorado State Teachers College in Greeley. She taught schools at Huntley and Lingle, Wyo.

Goldine married Halleck Driscoll on March 22, 1936. For a while, they lived in Nebraska and in Torrington, Wyo. In 1941, they moved to California. During the war, they worked at the Valencia Armory. They moved to Los Angeles and went to work for the Walt Disney Studios, training animals.

They started the Allied Dog Studios, where they trained different animals for the movie studios. After her husband's death in 1975, she continued to run the business until 1982, when she retired.

Goldine is survived by two aunts, Rena Wood and Laura Griffin, both of Wheatland. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one brother.
